2. PROPERTY RIGHTS TRANSFERRED TO THE LICENSEE

- 4.2. Upon expiration of this Agreement in the absence of written statements of termination from the Licensor and / or Licensee, the term of this Agreement is automatically extended for another 10 years, but not later than the expiration of the exclusive property right to the Work.
